



Ole Soccer Behavior Policy

Code of Conduct

Children are expected to display appropriate behavior at all times. To assure the maximum enjoyment of the program by all participants, please review the following guidelines with your child. Your child is expected, at minimum, to:

- Show respect to all participants, staff.
- Behave in a proper manner.
- Be pleasant to others and refrain from using foul language.
- Refrain from causing harm to self, other participants and staff.
- Use equipment, supplies and facilities properly.
- Always wear soccer gear.

Behavior

If behavior problems arise, you will be contacted that day to discuss the nature of the problem. The following disciplinary techniques may be used for uncooperative children:

- Time out: the child is removed from the activity (but not from the group) for duration of one minute for each year of age.
- In extreme cases a child may be removed from the activity area if they have difficulty controlling themselves. In this case, you will be contacted to handle the situation.
- If problems persist, we may request a conference with you. Children may be removed from the program if problems cannot be resolved.

Ole Stars Program:

The objective of this program is for kids to **Learn** and have **FUN** while participating in soccer classes. Kids between ages 18 months to 7 years old will be awarded a “Star sticker” at the end of the class if they have complied with the “Code of Conduct” and the “Behavior” policies.

Kids ages 18 months – 3 years old will receive a star regardless. However, if there is a behavior issue during the class, the Ole Stars Coach/Director will approach the parent to discuss the matter before the end of the day.
